General English

General English will provide you with a balance of the input and skills that you need to improve your English for everyday use. Of course we also cover grammar, [reading and writing](#) on these courses and the flexible syllabus means that our tutors can plan each week according to your needs.

With an average of 16 students per class (minimum 10, maximum 20) you will receive lots of individual attention but also have lots of opportunities to practise new language with your classmates.

Academic Year

On the Academic Year you will benefit from long-term language study while immersed in British life and culture. You can adapt your course to suit your personal needs by including exam preparation courses to help you get ready for university or employment.

This programme is based on the British university timetable with three 12-week terms of study separated by holidays to be taken at fixed times. On the Academic Year course.
